Saturday, March 29

Tuesday, April 1

- Transfer downtown where we will walk through the **Financial District** and see **Trinity Church, Wall Street, the New York Stock Exchange, and St. Paul's Chapel**.

- Lunch in **Central Park**.

Wednesday, April 2

- We will visit the **National Constitution Center**, an interactive museum devoted to the U.S. Constitution and the story of *we, the people*.
- Lunch.
- Visit Independence Hall, the old **Supreme Court**, and the **Liberty Bell**.
- Drive to **Lancaster County, PA** where will learn about **Amish** culture and enjoy an authentic Amish dinner.
- Drive to **Gettysburg**.
- Check in to our Gettysburg hotel.

Thursday, April 3

- Breakfast.
- Tour the **Gettysburg Museum** and see the **Cyclorama** presentation in preparation for our tour of Gettysburg National Battlefield with a Licensed Battlefield Guide.
- Guided tour of **Gettysburg National Battlefield**.
- Lunch before the drive back to DC.
- Arrive at **Arlington National Cemetery** where we will participate in a wreath laying ceremony at the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldiers**. We will also see the Challenger Memorial and the Kennedy Gravesites.
- After dinner, begin a night tour of the Monuments, including **Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, and Viet Nam Memorial**.
- Check in to our **Washington DC** hotel.

Friday, April 4

- Breakfast.
- Visit **Capitol Hill** where we see the **U.S. Capitol building**, and the **Supreme Court**. We will also visit the **Library of Congress** (time permitting.)

- Lunch and the rest of the afternoon will be spent exploring the museums of the **Smithsonian Institution**. Students will have an opportunity to visit the **Air and Space Museum, Museum of American History, and Natural History Museum**.
- Dinner at **Union Station**
